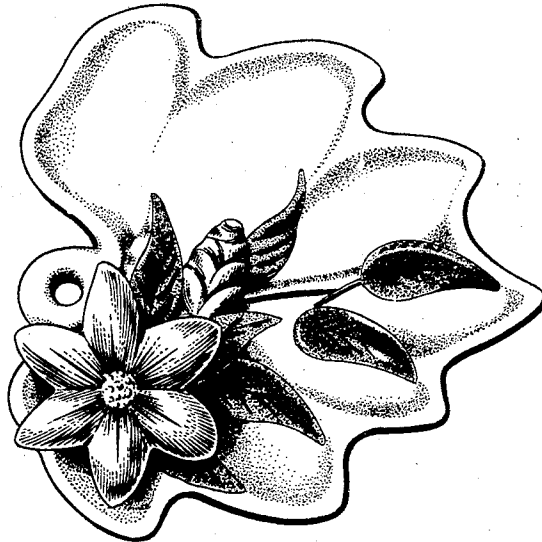

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, Clifford Potts, a citizen of the United States of America and a resident of Zanesville, in the county of Muskingum and State of Ohio, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for an Ash Tray or Similar Article, of which the following is the specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming a part thereof.

Figure 1 is a perspective view of an ash tray or similar article, showing my new design.

Figure 2 is a top plan view of the article shown in Figure 1.
